Translation progress

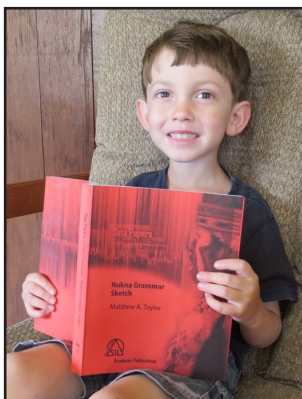
Thank you for your prayers for us and for the Nukna Bible translation program! By God's grace, we are continuing to make good progress:

- the book of Luke was checked by a translation consultant and given final approval
- a final team check of Acts was completed in preparation for village checking next month (see photo of checking team at right – Matt, Emson, Simendi and Enos). Please pray for these Nukna men as they hike around the Nukna area with the newly revised story of Peter and Cornelius from Acts 10, to share it in the Nukna language for the first time with the people.
- Muransi continues to do first drafts – all the books from Galatians to Titus have now been drafted and he is currently working on drafting Matthew. We now have 46% of the New Testament in at least first draft form.

Christy is continuing to volunteer two or three mornings a week at the medical clinic at the translation center here at Ukarumpa. She also taught Vacation Bible School for some of the local children (see photo at right). Now she is tackling the challenge of packing everything our family needs for flying to the remote Nukna area on June 16th. There are no stores out there, or any way to buy items that we forget, so planning well and packing everything we need is a vital task.

The *Nukna Grammar Sketch*, written by Matt over the last few years, has now been published in book form (see photo - Elijah is liking what he sees!). This is the first and only time the Nukna language has been described and documented. You can download an electronic copy for free at [this link](#).

Please pray for our family as we travel to Hamelengan village next month - for safety and good health as we live in such a remote area, for good progress as we village check the book of Acts with the Nukna people, and that God would be glorified.
